Please carefully read all terms and conditions (front and back) included in this contract. Sign the contract (on back) and return it with a check, money order, or credit card information for the total amount due (or minimum \$250 deposit). Please note the balance must be paid in full by February 3rd, 2008. A pre-addressed return label has been included for your convenience.

Event Dates: Three (3) days. Friday April 4th - Sunday April 6th, 2008.

Booth Specifications: Each booth is 8' X 10' and includes piping and drapery (10' back, 3' sides), one (1) electrical outlet, one (1) eight foot table, one (1) six foot table, two (2) chairs, plastic floor covering, and a sharps container. Additional tables/chairs will be provided as necessary.

Artist Requirements: A maximum of two (2) artists are permitted to work in anyone (1) booth.

Passes: The price of each booth includes a total of two (2) passes good for entry to the convention for the entire three (3) days. Additional passes may be pre-purchased at the price of \$25 each.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1.) New needles and tubes must be used for each tattoo/customer. All needles/tubes should be packaged separately in sealed bags and sterilized. Packaging may be done as kits (i.e. one outlining tube, one shading tube, one outlining needle, one shading needle), but all packages must be such that a new one is opened for each tattoo.
- 2.) Artists must wear Nitrile (or other industry accepted alternative) gloves at all times while tattooing and/or piercing.
- 3.) We will provide a photocopier, thermal copier, and autoclave for your use. All waste (OTHER THAN NEEDLES) may be disposed in the trash containers provided with your booth. We will provide Sharps containers (and disposal) for any used piercing/tattooing needles.
- 4.) A maximum of two (2) artists are permitted to work out of one (1) booth. In addition, tattooists are ONLY permitted to work out of booths that have been rented specifically for tattooing. Tattooing is NOT permitted in piercing or vendor booths.
- 5.) Since the level of privacy on the convention floor is minimal, tattoos and piercing of a sensitive nature may be performed in your hotel room at the discretion of you and your client. We do not condone work in rooms by individual who are not registered exhibitors of the convention and we will do everything in our power to ensure that it does not take place.
- 6.) Your booth must be manned at all times during convention hours. All booths should be open and ready for business according to the times listed below. The tattoo room will be cleared and locked by the times indicated. Please judge yourself accordingly and leave a reasonable amount of time to finish any work in progress.

- 7.) Banners/signs are permissible, but they may only be attached to the piping in your stand with the hooks provided. You will be responsible for any damage to piping and/or drapery in your booth.
- 8.) The garbage cans and electrical equipment in your booth are provided by the convention services company and/or the hotel. They must NOT BE REMOVED from the booth. You will be responsible for any missing equipment.
- 9.) Aside from the items noted in this contract, exhibitors are responsible for all other materials that they deem necessary to conduct business: i.e. utility strips, extra lighting, paper towels, distilled water, etc.
- 10.) All business transactions and the liabilities associated with those transactions are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor and/or customer involved.
- 11.) The convention room will be cleared and locked during non-convention hours. Plain clothes security guards will patrol the halls surrounding the convention room overnight. No one will be permitted in the room except in extreme circumstances and unless accompanied by a Quillian Tattoo staff member. These measures are taken to ensure the safety of the persons in attendance and property present at this event. However, Quillian Tattoo/ Ventre Entertainment assumes no liability whatsoever for any accident, injury, damage, or loss caused to any person or property, arising directly or indirectly from this event.

In signing this contract, I have read, understand, and agree to comply to all terms stated herein. Failure to comply is grounds for dismissal from the event. No refund shall be given under such circumstances. I understand that Quillian Tattool Ventre Entertainment is in no way liable for any accident, injury, damage, or loss caused to any person or property, arising directly or indirectly from this event.
